

Rome Summer School in Latin Expression of Interest Form

29th June to 19th July 2014

Please complete and submit the Expression of Interest form below by Friday, 6 September 2013, in order to determine the number of interested participants for the 2014 Rome Summer School and viability of the program. Completion of this form is not binding.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Cost of the Rome Summer School includes the Land Component and the following tuition fees:

- for non-credit earning students - **\$ 990**;
- for credit earning students - **\$1,995** – The Campion credit earning students are eligible for 6 credit points. If you are a student from another institution, you will be required to check with your institution. Knowledge of basic Latin is required to enroll as a credit earning student. **Credit earning students can defer tuition fees through FeeHelp.**

The Land Component is approximately **2,850.00** and covers:

- accommodation in twin-bedded rooms including breakfast;
- three half-day and one weekend land excursions,
- two dinners,
- entry to museums and archeological sites.

The total cost payable to the College is estimated **\$4,845** for credit earning students (who can defer their tuition fees through FeeHelp) and **\$3,840** for non-credit earning students (who have to pay the full amount upfront). Participants are also responsible for booking and paying for their own airfares to Rome, travel insurance, and airport transfers. Participants should allow at least €25 – 30 per day for meals other than those as stated above.

The School will include a reasonable amount of walking and visits to archaeological diggings. Participants should be able to endure heat and be fit to travel.

Full terms & conditions (including final costs) and a detailed program of study will be provided to the prospective participants by 1 October 2013 and they will be asked to officially enroll.

ENROLMENT AND PAYMENT PROCESS (for information only)

1. Students must confirm their participation by lodging an enrolment form and paying 25% of the Land Component by 31 October 2013. The first payment is not refundable for change of mind.
2. The balance of the Land Component must be paid in three installments 25% each by 1/12/13, 1/1/14 and 1/2/14.
3. Tuition fees in full should be paid by 30th April 2014. Credit-earning students only will be allowed to defer their tuition fee using Fee-Help.
