Letter of Parental Consent

Dear Parent,

We are delighted that your son/daughter would like to attend the 2014 Latin Summer School. Here is some information to enable you to understand what is involved.

The aim of the LSS is to foster interest in and knowledge of Latin and the Ancient World. It is designed primarily for adults but attendees of all ages above 14 are welcome. As the name indicates it is a serious summer school, not a 'camp', and does not aim to teach Latin School Syllabus texts.

In addition, all school age students who attend are expected to act at all times in a totally mature manner, which includes looking after themselves during the breaks. They will not be supervised by staff at such times. Naturally, they are required to behave appropriately during all the classes and lectures they attend, in fact to be like attentive and interested young undergraduates, and to conduct themselves in a manner that is conducive to the enjoyment of all involved, most of whom are adults. As you will understand, inattentive, discourteous or disruptive behavior is not only totally unacceptable but will not be able to be tolerated.

We believe that, with appropriate expectations, your son/daughter will enjoy the Latin Summer School and help contribute to the enjoyment of others.
